As part of our VBS missions we are collecting school supplies for BEAM (Beaches Emergency Assistance Ministry) and for the children in Costa Rica. We are also collecting rain gear, rubber boots, Crocs and flip flops for the children in Costa Rica. The collection will run today through next Sunday.

Next Sunday we'll participate in a **Service of Healing** both at 9:30 and 11:00. A Service of Healing is not necessarily a service of *curing*, but it provides an atmosphere in which healing can happen. Pastor Jeff's message will focus on God's promise to sustain us throughout our suffering. Psalm 91 is the text; "My Refuge and My Fortress", the title.

What do **passionate worship, radical hospitality, intentional discipling, salty service and extravagant generosity** have in common? They characterized the people caught up in the Methodist movement as it swept across England and America. There's nothing uniquely United Methodist about these practices; their roots are planted firmly in Scripture and they are practiced well today when any congregation lives up to its Kingdom potential. Pastor Jeff begins a five week series on these core practices of the Christian faith two weeks from today.
