Salty Service

Beginning this morning each Sunday you'll find a salty service "ticket" in your bulletin. **If you've served beyond the local church for an hour or more in the past week, please put the card in the offering plate.** There's nothing to fill out; we're simply tracking the percentage of those in attendance who have served in the past week to help us know if we're growing as salty servants.

What kinds of service are we talking about here? Included would be

- service done to make a positive difference in the lives of others that you would not have done were it not for your relationship to Christ
- service requiring hands-on, face-to-face engagement with the needs of people that you might not ordinarily come to know
- service that pushes you out of your comfort zone to make a real difference in the lives of people

Examples of things several of us are involved in include soup kitchen, detention center, volunteering at the hospital, Hart Felt Ministries, Habitat for Humanity, scouting, even building a relationship with someone far from Christ.
