A Note From Pastor Jeff:

I'm going to Cuba! From time to time our Jacksonville district sends a "caravan" of pastors and lay people to our sister district (Havana) of the Methodist Church of Cuba. A pastor scheduled to travel in May has dropped off the team and I've been invited to go in his place. I look forward to getting to know our sister church, **La Sierra Methodist**. I was privileged to visit Cuba as part of a work team in 1998 and am looking forward to returning. The church in Cuba is very strong, despite the hardships of following Christ in that communist country. I expect to learn much and share much too.

Would you like to go with me? Okay, there's no room in the caravan right now but I'd love to take some letters with me from you to church members there. Let me know that you'd like to write and I'll e-mail Pastor Correa for the name of a "pen pal" for you. Write about anything you like... your family, our church, how you spend your time, whatever.

Our team of six is scheduled for **May 22 - 29**. We have the needed permission from the United States side. Now we wait for the Cuba Conference's acceptance of the May dates and the processing of the permission for visas from Cuba itself.

Please continue to **pray for our sister church**. They own a church building but not a parsonage. Their one specific prayer request to date has been for permission from the Cuban government to build a parsonage. We own a parsonage but not a church building. **They are praying for us.**
