9:00am - Noon

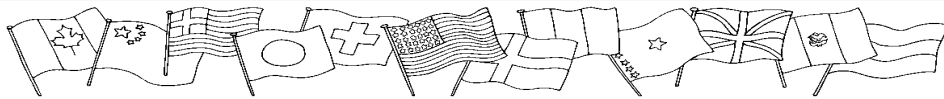
