Well Done, Good and Faithful Servants

Our goal for 2004 was to give 10% of undesignated tithes and offerings to missions, and another 10% to the Building/Property Acquisition Fund. At our level of giving, that would mean \$41,000 to each effort. Ponte Vedra United Methodist Church, you did well! We fell short of our very ambitious goal by \$8,000 but because we underspent our '04 budget, we did not claim \$8,000 of district new church start monies available to us. That \$8,000 has gone toward the start of other new churches in the Jacksonville district. With \$33,000 from undesignated tithes and offerings and another \$9,500 in designated missions giving, an astounding \$42,500 is being given by us to work beyond our local church. Check out the Missions Corner in this and future issues of *The Wave* to see where that money is being put to work.

On the building fund side, our Finance team felt it prudent to begin the year with more than \$0 on hand; so \$7,000 of the \$41,000 we'd hoped would go toward building is being retained in the general fund. Added to the \$34,000 credited to the building fund is \$47,800 in designated giving, \$81,800 in all.

A great time was had by all at last summer's hymn sing. Let's do it again! Pastor Jeff has promised not to make those who gather learn his favorite golden oldie, *The Awakening Chorus*. Ash Wednesday Service February 9

Ash Wednesday is the name given to the first day of the season of Lent, in which the pastor applies ashes to the foreheads of Christians while saying,

"Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return," or

"Repent and believe the gospel."

The ashes remind us of the most bitter fruit of our sin: death. We are also reminded of our need to repent (turn from sin and toward God) and to receive the good news that through Jesus Christ there is forgiveness for sin.

Ash Wednesday, like the season of Lent, is never mentioned in the Bible; Christians are free to either observe it or not. We will be offering the service. Hopefully those who come will find themselves all the more grateful that God rescued them from sin and death through Jesus Christ and all the more serious about their repentance. The service is at 7:00pm, Wednesday, February 9. 6:00 activities will be dismissed at 6:45 and 7:00 activities delayed until 7:45 so that all who desire may come.

A Note From Pastor Jeff:

There's an unseen risk whenever a church (or a person, for that matter) embarks on a God ordained mission. The risk is that we will allow the endeavor itself to supersede the One who calls us to it.

That risk exists with our upcoming capital stewardship program. While we hope to meet and even surpass our \$1.2 million goal, if it's about raising money, we've missed the point. We could probably raise the money without a single person growing in their relationship with Christ and that would be tragic.

Recently I was re-reading a portion of Richard Foster's classic work, *Celebration of Discipline; the Path to Spiritual Growth*. Foster reminds us of these words of Jesus, words that will keep us on track if we follow them.

Seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well
- Matthew 6:33

Raise money to provide a home for the church? No, seek first God's kingdom. Give away all your money so that the poor will have enough? No, seek first God's kingdom. Go out and preach sound stewardship principles? Seek first God's kingdom and the righteousness, both personal and social, of that kingdom. And unconnected people will become connected, hungry people will be fed, and the church will have its home.

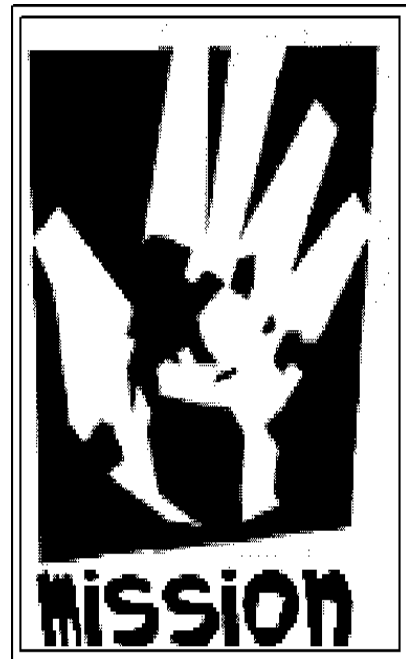
