2008 Offering Envelopes

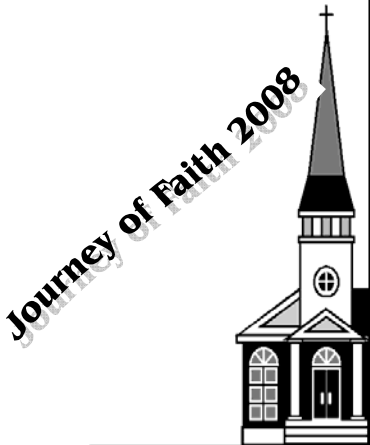
