**The Blood Alliance has changed their policy on walk-ins.** In all fairness to those individuals with appointments, walk-ins will only be accepted if there is an available appointment slot. So please make an appointment for a time that you will be able to donate.

Anyone who is in good health, at least 17 years old and weighs at least 110 pounds may donate blood every 56 days. We are currently in the 56 day window for our next drive, so **please don't give blood between now and January 30.** There is no upper age limit to donate, as long as your doctor says it is okay.

Please help. Remember, one donation can save up to three lives. **A photo ID is required to donate.**
